2023/24 Senior Captain Role Descriptions



The Maroochydore Cricket Club is a community club whose mission is to provide cricket for all those wishing to play regardless of their level or previous experience. We aim to provide an experience which is enjoyable for all players and club members both on and off the field. All Senior Team Captains are required to be proactive in upholding the values of the club by playing hard but fair on the field, and fostering a club environment which is welcoming of all.

As a Senior Team Captain of Maroochydore Cricket Club, your responsibilities include the following:

- Foster an environment which ensures all players enjoy their cricketing experience at Maroochydore Cricket Club.
- Contribute to positive club culture through the inclusion of all players in cricket and social events, and to foster an attitude of club loyalty and responsibility.
- Attend training at least once per week to allow for personal and team preparation, and encourage players within your respective team to attend trainings at least once per week.
- Organise team-based training/fielding sessions in consultation with club coaches as necessary
- Be readily available for necessary team-related communications. This includes providing honest and impartial feedback to selectors, communicating regarding the selections of teams and players, and providing open feedback to club coaches with the goal of improving and developing players and teams.
- Support decisions made by coaches, selectors and committee members for the betterment of the club and be open to receiving and actioning constructive feedback where necessary for the betterment of the team and club.
- Be prepared and organised for matchday including collection and organisation of scorebooks and scoring implements, balls and uniforms.
- Be proactive and innovative in finding ways to contribute to the development of club culture, environment and atmosphere through social events.
- Demonstrate an ability to handle and communicate to different personalities both on and off the field, and to be considerate and aware of the development of all players, especially those beginning their senior cricketing careers at Maroochydore Cricket Club.
- Encourage fair play, the spirit of cricket and ensure all team members are compliant with the Maroochydore Cricket Club's Code of Conduct.
- Report any poor behaviour, misconduct or disciplinary issues unbecoming of a Maroochydore Cricket Club player.
- Ensure playing areas, changerooms and surrounds are left clean and in the manner they were found, both at home and away venues.
- Ensuring that representatives from your team are organised and available to assist with off-field duties, where necessary, including;
 - Gameday ground preparation
 - Pre-game canteen assistance
 - Sunday ground preparation for events
 - Post-game social events
